

# The Feast of St Peter and St Paul

5:00 p.m., Saturday, June 29, 2024

*The texts found below are those of the chants and prayers which change each week and are sung by the choir and celebrant alone.*

**Members of the congregation are invited to join the choir in the chants that are printed with music in the Mass booklet (“Sancta Eucharistia”).**

## **(1) Introitus** Acts 12: 11; Psalm 139

Nunc scio vere, quia misit Dominus angelum suum: et eripuit me de manu Herodis, et de omni exspectatione plebis Iudaeorum. *Ps.* Domine probasti me, et cognovisti me: tu cognovisti sessionem meam, et resurrectionem meam.

Now I am sure that the Lord has sent his angel and rescued me from the hands of Herod and from all that the Jewish people were expecting. *V.* LORD, you have searched me out and known me; you know my sitting down and my rising up.

## **(2) Collecta**

Omnipotens Deus, cuius beati apostoli Petrus et Paulus martyrio suo te glorificaverunt: Concede ut Ecclesia tua, doctrina et exemplo eorum erudita, atque Spiritu tuo in unitate coniuncta, semper persistet super fundamentum unum Iesum Christum Dominum nostrum; qui tecum vivit et regnat in unitate Spiritus Sancti, Deus, per omnia saecula saeculorum. *Amen.*

Almighty God, whose blessed apostles Peter and Paul glorified you by their martyrdom: Grant that your Church, instructed by their teaching and example, and knit together in unity by your Spirit, may ever stand firm upon the one foundation, which is Jesus Christ our Lord; who lives and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. *Amen.*

## **(3) Alleluia** Matthew 16: 18

Alleluia. Tu es Petrus, et super hanc petram aedificabo Ecclesiam meam.

Alleluia. You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.

**Evangelium** (*Gospel Reading*): John 21:15-19

## **(4) Offertorium** Psalm 45: 17, 18

Constitues eos principes super omnem terram: memores erunt nominis tui, in omni progenie et generatione.

You shall make them princes over all the earth. I will make your name to be remembered from one generation to another.

**(5) Praefatio De Apostolis**

Per Iesum Christum Dominum nostrum, gregis tui pastorem magnum; qui post resurrectionem apostolos suos legavit ad praedicandum Evangelium et omnes gentes docendas; et promisit ut cum eis maneat omnibus diebus usque ad consummationem saeculi.

Through the great shepherd of your flock, Jesus Christ our Lord; who after his resurrection sent forth his apostles to preach the Gospel and to teach all nations; and promised to be with them always, even to the end of the ages.

**(6) Communio Matthew 16: 18**

Tu es Petrus, et super hanc petram aedificabo Ecclesiam meam.

You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.

**(7) Postcommunio**

Da nobis, Domine, hoc sacramento refectis, ita in Ecclesia conversari, ut, perseverantes in fractione panis apostolorumque doctrina, cor unum simus et anima una, tua caritate firmati. Per Christum Dominum nostrum. *Amen.*

Strengthen with your love, O Lord, those whom you have refreshed with this sacrament: that continuing in the breaking of bread and in the teaching of the apostles, we may serve you with one heart and one mind in your holy Church; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
